Peep-Ters Institute is strategically located near Daewoo Estate, Kotwi-Nkransa, Kumasi..

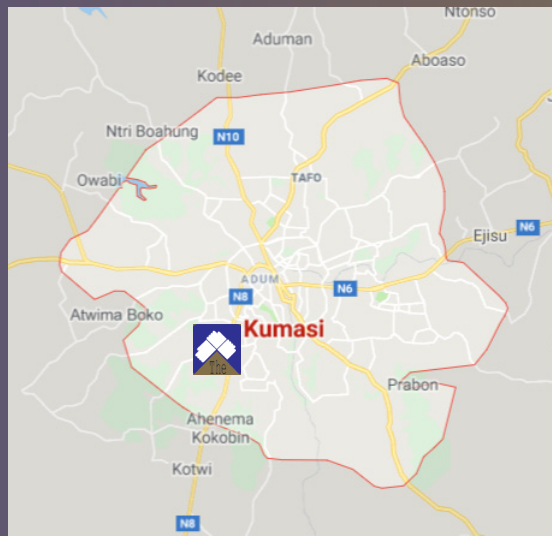
The center is a joint project of MEF and The Extension (USA), based on The Extension's successful model.

Admission Process

The team at Peep-Ters strives to make the referral process as smooth and pleasant as possible for our referral sources, families, and patients as they transition into our treatment programs.

To refer directly to any of our programs, simply contact our Intake team. We will pre-screen each referral to determine the most appropriate level of care. We will arrange for transportation if needed. Treatment begins immediately upon acceptance.

Providers can also help a client access treatment by having them call our intake team independently. Patients can walk in or schedule a free confidential assessment by one of our mental health professionals.

CLINICAL PASTORAL EDUCATION

Is training focused on providing skills based holistic approach of care to empower religious leaders in Healthcare and other HealthCare personnel. The program of training is based on a CPE model of 3 months period (ie. one CPE unit) at a time of Clinical Pastoral Education. Students from Emory University, Atlanta USA will join prospective students from Ghana at the Institute for training.
